GGFA inaugurated at Denkyemuoso

Dekeyemuoso, Oct.7, GNA - The German-Ghanaian Friendship Association (GGFA), a non-governmental organization (NGO), seeking to help the needy and the poor in society, was inaugurated at Denkyemuoso in Kumasi. It also aims at fostering German-Ghanaian relations and planning for exchange programmes for members in the two countries.
